- 1. Major Initiatives of IQAC for (2018-19):
- IQAC Cell coordinated Periodic Staff meetings, Department meetings, Board of Studies, Academic Council
- 3. HOD's Appraisal by the Department Colleagues and Self-Appraisal by the Lecturer was conducted.
- 4. Faculty Development Programmes
- On 27th July 2018 Faculty Development Programme was organized. Dr. Vijay H. Jariwala, Professor, Department of Economics, SPU, was the Resource Person for administration and Team Building Skills.
- 6. Faculty research
- A number of seminars were attended by lecturers organized by various Colleges.
- 8. Faculties also presented papers at State, National and International Seminars.
- 9. Many papers were published by faculty members.
- In association with Dark Horse Academy for Competitive Exams, Career Counselling Workshop was organized for the students.
- 11. A Dessert Competition was organized by Women Cell on 03/08/2018 to boost up students potentiality.
- 12. A Guest lecture was organized under Jashkamal Vyakhyanmala on 04/08/2018. Shri Maheshbhai Prajapati, a critic cum rhetorical poet was invited. He talked on the various aspects of writing and also presented his own poems and Chappa that contained irony in it.
- 13. On 5th September 2018- Teachers' Day was celebrated, followed by entertainment programme by the students.
- One Day Research Workshop for PhD Scholars was conducted on 14/09/2018 i.e. International Hindi Day to cultivate research aptitude and enhance research skills.

- 15. A Guest lecture was organized under Jashkamal Vyakhyanmala on 22/09/2018. Eminent artists of theatre performance Shri P.O.Joshi and Shri Janak Vyas were invited as guest speakers who shared their views on dramaturgy and also dramatized and spoke dialogues.
- 16. A Workshop on 'Ghandhi Vichar-Lekhan-Vanchan' was organized on 02/10/2018 to inculcate reading and analytical skills of the students.
- 17. On 26th December 2018, one day Out Reach Programme was organized and took visit to Orphanage.
- 18. Literary Club conducted various competitions like essay writing, poetry recitation, elocution competition, Mehandi Competition, debate and collage competition.
- 19. Gujarat Sahitya Akademi sponsored one Day State Level Seminar on "Charotar na Sant-Bhakt Kavio" was organised by the institute on 04/01/2019.
- 20. The Department of Gujarati arranged a screening of Guajarati movie 'Reva' which is an adaptation of Guajarati novel "Tatvamasi" prescribed in syllabus on 01/02/2019.
- 21. The institute organized a study trip to Tirupati Rushivan and Indroda Nature Park Gandhinagar on 12/02/2019.
- 22. On 8th March 2019 International Women's Day was celebrated. Two documentaries short films based on real life women were shown to the students to instil the sense of empowerment and to touch gender sensation issue.

Library has subscribed 15 periodicals in both English and Vernacular languages. The library also has access to online catalogues and libraries such as N LIST, Infilbnet and online access for students and staff.
